## AN ACT

1 Requiring a transfer from the Realty Transfer Tax Account in the  
2 General Fund to the Deferred Maintenance Account.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Transfer of funds.

6 Effective for fiscal years beginning with ~~1993-1994~~ 1994- <—  
7 1995, 10% of the cash from the Realty Transfer Tax Account in  
8 the General Fund shall be transferred to a restricted receipt  
9 account in the State Treasury, known as the Deferred Maintenance  
10 Account, to be used for deferred maintenance projects at State  
11 parks, historical sites and museums owned by the Pennsylvania  
12 Historical and Museum Commission and educational facilities  
13 owned by the State System of Higher Education. The transfer from  
14 the Realty Transfer Tax Account in the General Fund to the  
15 Deferred Maintenance Account required by this section shall be

1 made on the last day of each month for the current month  
2 beginning with the transfer on July 31, ~~1993~~ 1994.

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3 Section 2. Report.

4 Within 30 days of the ~~effective date of this act~~ DATE THIS  
5 ACT BECOMES APPLICABLE, and annually by January 31, the  
6 Department of Environmental Resources, the Pennsylvania  
7 Historical and Museum Commission and the State System of Higher  
8 Education shall submit to the Governor and the majority chairman  
9 and the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the  
10 Senate and the majority chairman and the minority chairman of  
11 the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives a  
12 report of maintenance projects at State parks, historical sites  
13 and museums and educational facilities, respectively, which have  
14 been deferred together with a proposed schedule for performing  
15 deferred maintenance projects and an estimate of the cost of  
16 each deferred maintenance project.

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17 Section 3. Appropriation.

18 Effective for fiscal years beginning with ~~1993-1994~~ 1994-  
19 1995, the General Assembly shall appropriate money from the  
20 Deferred Maintenance Account for deferred maintenance projects  
21 at State parks, historical sites and museums owned by the  
22 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission and educational  
23 facilities owned by the State System of Higher Education. For  
24 fiscal years beginning with ~~1993-1994~~ 1994-1995 and ending with  
25 ~~1997-1998~~ 1998-1999, at least 55% of the amount appropriated  
26 from the Deferred Maintenance Account shall be appropriated for  
27 deferred maintenance projects at State parks, at least 15% shall  
28 be appropriated for deferred maintenance projects at historical  
29 sites and museums owned by the Pennsylvania Historical and  
30 Museum Commission, and at least 25% shall be appropriated for

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1 deferred maintenance projects at educational facilities owned by  
2 the State System of Higher Education.

3 SECTION 4. APPLICABILITY. <—

4 THIS ACT SHALL APPLY TO FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING ON OR AFTER  
5 JULY 1, 1994.

6 Section 4 5. Effective date. <—

7 This act shall take effect immediately.
