## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public
- 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth, " requiring school
- 4 attendance as a condition of eligibility for general
- 5 assistance.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 402 of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31,
- 9 No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a
- 10 definition to read:
- 11 Section 402. Definitions.--As used in this article:
- 12 \* \* \*
- "Minor in need of education" means a minor who:
- 14 (1) is at least five years of age, but less than eighteen
- 15 years of age; and
- 16 (2) does not have a high school diploma or a certificate
- 17 <u>deemed equivalent to a high school diploma by the Department of</u>
- 18 Education.
- 19 \* \* \*

- 1 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 2 <u>Section 405.3. School Attendance Program.--(a) Prior to the</u>
- 3 <u>authorization of general assistance</u>, every individual shall
- 4 demonstrate to the department that any minor in need of
- 5 education who resides with the individual is regularly attending
- 6 school.
- 7 (b) If the department determines, after a hearing, that a
- 8 minor in need of education who resides with an individual
- 9 receiving general assistance is not regularly attending school,
- 10 general assistance shall be terminated until the individual can
- 11 again demonstrate to the department that the minor in need of
- 12 <u>education is regularly attending school.</u>
- 13 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
