AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the crime of auto  
3 piracy.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 3702. Auto piracy.

9 A person commits a felony of the first degree who, whether  
10 armed or unarmed, by force or violence, by threat of force or  
11 violence or by putting a person in fear of death or bodily harm  
12 robs, steals or takes a motor vehicle from another person in the  
13 presence of that person or any other person in lawful possession  
14 of the motor vehicle.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
