AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
5 laws relating thereto," providing for payments for magnet
6 programs.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11 section to read:

12 Section 2509.10. Payments for Magnet Programs.--Each school
13 district shall receive two hundred dollars (\$200) for the first
14 year and one hundred dollars (\$100) for each year thereafter for
15 each student enrolled in a magnet program. The Secretary of
16 Education shall determine whether the program qualifies for
17 designation as a magnet program. The program shall have a
18 curriculum with a special academic emphasis or curriculum
19 concentration in grades kindergarten through twelve. Programs in

- 1 schools operated by a joint board or provided through
- 2 arrangements with other districts shall be eligible for funding.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1993.
