AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 2 act relating to the public school system, including certa 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- 5 laws relating thereto, providing for payments for magnet
- 6 programs.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 2509.10. Payments for Magnet Programs. -- Each school
- 13 <u>district shall receive two hundred dollars (\$200) for the first</u>
- 14 year and one hundred dollars (\$100) for each year thereafter for
- 15 each student enrolled in a magnet program. The Secretary of
- 16 Education shall determine whether the program qualifies for
- 17 <u>designation as a magnet program. The program shall have a</u>
- 18 curriculum with a special academic emphasis or curriculum
- 19 concentration in grades kindergarten through twelve. Programs in

- 1 schools operated by a joint board or provided through
- 2 <u>arrangements with other districts shall be eligible for funding.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1993.
