1 2 3 4	Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for a cause of action for risking infection with acquired immune deficiency syndrome.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 8311. Action for exposure to acquired immune deficiency
10	syndrome.
11	(a) Cause of action An action may be brought, under
12	procedures prescribed by general rules, to recover damages for
13	exposure to acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS).
14	(b) Elements The elements of a cause of action under this
15	section are:
16	(1) The defendant engaged in sexual intercourse with the
17	plaintiff.

(2) At the time of the sexual intercourse under

- 1 paragraph (1), the defendant:
- 2 <u>(i) was a carrier of the human immunodeficiency</u>
- 3 virus (HIV); and
- 4 <u>(ii) had knowledge of being a carrier of the human</u>
- 5 <u>immunodeficiency virus.</u>
- 6 (3) The defendant did not notify the plaintiff that the
- 7 <u>defendant was a carrier of the human immunodeficiency virus</u>
- 8 prior to engaging in the sexual intercourse under paragraph
- 9 (1).
- 10 (c) Recovery not barred. -- Failure of the plaintiff to
- 11 contract acquired immune deficiency syndrome as a result of
- 12 sexual intercourse under subsection (b)(1) shall not bar
- 13 <u>recovery under this section.</u>
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
