AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for persons ineligible for
3 licensing.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1503(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

8 § 1503. Persons ineligible for licensing.

9 (a) General rule.--The department shall not issue any
10 driver's license to, or renew the driver's license of, any
11 person:

12 * * *

13 (9) Who is under 21 years of age and has been convicted
14 under 18 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to firearms and other
15 dangerous articles) of possessing illegal firearms or other

1 weapons on the property of a school or a school bus. AN
2 UNLICENSED PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE MAY NOT BE ISSUED A
3 LICENSE UNTIL THE PERSON IS 21 YEARS OF AGE OR FOR TWO YEARS,
4 WHICHEVER IS LONGER. If the person is already licensed under
5 this chapter, the department shall suspend the license until
6 the person is 21 years of age or for two years, whichever is
7 longer.

9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
