## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), entitled "An act to consolidate, editorially revise, and codify the public 3 welfare laws of the Commonwealth, " requiring the Department of Public Welfare to make unannounced visits to and 5 inspections of nursing and personal care homes; AND FURTHER PROVIDING FOR INSPECTION OF CARE FACILITIES. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 911(a) of the act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by 10 adding a clause to read: 11 12 Section 911. Visitation and Inspection. -- (a) The department shall have the power, and its duty shall be: 14 15 (3) To inspect nursing and personal care homes within this 16 Commonwealth, unannounced and without notice, to determine the

standard of care being administered to residents.

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- SECTION 2. SECTION 1016 OF THE ACT, AMENDED JULY 15, 1976 <--2
- 3 (P.L.993, NO.202), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 4 SECTION 1016. RIGHT TO ENTER AND INSPECT. -- FOR THE PURPOSE
- OF DETERMINING THE SUITABILITY OF THE APPLICANTS AND OF THE 5
- PREMISES OR WHETHER OR NOT ANY PREMISES IN FACT QUALIFIES AS A 6
- FACILITY AS DEFINED IN SECTION 1001 OF THIS ACT OR THE 7
- CONTINUING CONFORMITY OF THE LICENSEES TO THIS ACT AND TO THE
- 9 APPLICABLE REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT, ANY AUTHORIZED AGENT
- 10 OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO ENTER, VISIT AND
- 11 INSPECT ANY FACILITY LICENSED OR REQUIRING A LICENSE UNDER THIS
- 12 ACT AND SHALL HAVE FULL AND FREE ACCESS TO THE RECORDS OF THE
- 13 FACILITY AND TO THE INDIVIDUALS THEREIN AND FULL OPPORTUNITY TO
- 14 INTERVIEW, INSPECT OR EXAMINE SUCH INDIVIDUALS. IF THE FACILITY
- 15 IS A PERSONAL CARE HOME, THE INSPECTION SHALL BE UNANNOUNCED AND
- 16 WITHOUT NOTICE.
- 17 AN AUTHORIZED AGENT OF THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALSO CONFER WITH
- 18 THE OPERATORS OF FACILITIES REGARDING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS OF
- 19 THE DEPARTMENT, ENCOURAGE THE ADOPTION OF HIGHER STANDARDS AND

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- 20 RECOMMEND METHODS OF IMPROVING CARE AND SERVICES.
- Section 2 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 21
