AN ACT

- 1 Requiring the Commonwealth to maintain certain health insurance 2 coverage for certain Commonwealth annuitants.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Legislative findings and purpose.
- 6 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (1) For the last 20 years or longer, the Commonwealth
- 9 has provided a comprehensive group health insurance program
- 10 for Commonwealth annuitants.
- 11 (2) Among the various health insurance packages, the
- 12 Commonwealth extended an option to annuitants to choose
- 13 Medicare Part B and Blue Shield 65-Special or remaining in
- the Blue Shield portion of Basic Health Coverage.
- 15 (3) Pursuant to the option under paragraph (2),
- 16 approximately 4,000 Commonwealth annuitants elected to retain
- 17 the Blue Shield portion of Basic Health Coverage.

- 1 (4) On or about July 1988, the Commonwealth and the
- 2 collective bargaining units for Commonwealth employees agreed
- 3 to the establishment of a jointly administered trust fund for
- 4 the purpose of providing a comprehensive group health
- 5 insurance program.
- 6 (5) On or about late 1991, the board responsible for the
- 7 administration of the trust fund adopted a proposal which
- 8 withdrew the option under paragraph (2) and required all
- 9 annuitants, both current and future, to pick Medicare Part B
- 10 coverage along with Blue Shield 65-Special.
- 11 (6) The approximately 4,000 annuitants who exercised
- 12 their option were or will be required to pick up coverage
- 13 under Medicare Part B with substantial and continuous
- 14 penalties.
- 15 (b) Purpose. -- The General Assembly intends to require the
- 16 Commonwealth to meet its obligations to the current Commonwealth
- 17 annuitants.
- 18 Section 2. Commonwealth responsibility.
- 19 The Commonwealth shall be responsible for and liable for:
- 20 (1) The provision of the Blue Shield portion of Basic
- 21 Health Coverage to all current Commonwealth annuitants who
- 22 elected the option to retain the Blue Shield portion of Basic
- 23 Health Coverage.
- 24 (2) If the Commonwealth annuitant enrolled in Medicare
- 25 Part B coverage as a result of the withdrawal of the option
- under section 1(a)(2), then the Commonwealth shall be liable
- for the basic cost of Medicare Part B and any penalty which
- 28 may be assessed against the annuitant.
- 29 (3) If the Commonwealth annuitant enrolled in another
- 30 comprehensive health insurance program as a result of the

- 1 withdrawal of the option under section 1(a)(2), then the
- Commonwealth shall be liable for the costs incurred in 2
- 3 obtaining this comprehensive health insurance coverage.
- 4 Section 3. Retroactivity.
- This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1991. 5
- 6 Section 4. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately. 7
