AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for violations concerning
3 driver's licenses.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1571 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1571. Violations concerning licenses.

9 (a) Offenses defined.--It is unlawful for any person:

10 (1) To exhibit or cause or permit to be exhibited or
11 have in possession any recalled, canceled, suspended,
12 revoked[, disqualified, fictitious or fraudulently] or
13 materially altered driver's license.

14 (2) To give, sell or lend a driver's license to any
15 other person or permit the use thereof by another.

16 (3) To purchase, exhibit or represent as one's own any
17 driver's license not issued to the person.

18 (4) To fail or refuse to surrender to [the department] a

1 person to whom authority to seize driver's licenses has been
2 delegated by the department under section 1540(c) (relating
3 to surrender of license) upon lawful demand a recalled,
4 canceled, suspended, revoked[, disqualified, fictitious or
5 fraudulently] or materially altered driver's license.

6 (5) To permit any person to represent himself as another
7 when undergoing one or more of the examinations authorized
8 under Subchapter A (relating to general provisions).

9 (6) To undergo an examination authorized under
10 Subchapter A on behalf of another person.

11 (7) In an application or form required under this
12 chapter, to use a false or fictitious name, to give a false
13 or fictitious address, to make a false statement, to conceal
14 a material fact or otherwise to commit a fraud.

15 (8) To possess, sell or attempt to sell a counterfeit
16 driver's license or to fail or refuse to surrender a
17 counterfeit driver's license to a qualified Commonwealth
18 employee or agent authorized by the department or to a police
19 officer upon lawful demand.

20 (b) Penalty.--

21 (1) Any person [violating any of the provisions of this
22 section is guilty of] who violates subsection (a)(1), (2),
23 (3), (4), (5) or (6) commits a summary offense and shall,
24 upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$100.

25 (2) Any person who violates subsection (a)(7) or (8)
26 commits a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon
27 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$500.

28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
