AN ACT

1 Repealing the act of October 4, 1978 (P.L.876, No.169), entitled
2 "An act establishing the Pennsylvania Crime Commission and
3 providing for its powers and duties."

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. The act of October 4, 1978 (P.L.876, No.169),
7 known as the Pennsylvania Crime Commission Act, is repealed.

8 Section 2. All files and records of the Pennsylvania Crime
9 Commission shall be transferred to the Pennsylvania State
10 Police.

11 Section 3. All appropriations to the Pennsylvania Crime
12 Commission shall lapse into the General Fund.

13 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
