## AN ACT

- 1 Repealing the act of October 4, 1978 (P.L.876, No.169), entitled
  - "An act establishing the Pennsylvania Crime Commission and
- 3 providing for its powers and duties."
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The act of October 4, 1978 (P.L.876, No.169),
- 7 known as the Pennsylvania Crime Commission Act, is repealed.
- 8 Section 2. All files and records of the Pennsylvania Crime
- 9 Commission shall be transferred to the Pennsylvania State
- 10 Police.

- 11 Section 3. All appropriations to the Pennsylvania Crime
- 12 Commission shall lapse into the General Fund.
- 13 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
