AN ACT

1 Reenacting the proceeds disposition provision of the act of June
2 18, 1982 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for
3 the administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within
4 the Department of Agriculture."

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 7.1(a) of the act of June 18, 1982
8 (P.L.549, No.159), entitled "An act providing for the
9 administration of certain Commonwealth farmland within the
10 Department of Agriculture," added May 13, 1988 (P.L.398, No.64),
11 is reenacted to read:

12 Section 7.1. Proceeds from the sale of land, equipment or
13 facilities.

14 (a) Proceeds from the sale of all land, or portions of land,
15 equipment or facilities, transferred to the Department of
16 Agriculture under this act and subsequently disposed of by the

1 Commonwealth under Article XXIV-A of the act of April 9, 1929
2 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,
3 shall, notwithstanding any other provision of the law to the
4 contrary, be credited to the Agricultural Conservation Easement
5 Purchase Fund.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
