1 2 3 4 5 6	"Amending the act of February 19, 1980 (P.L.15, No.9), entitled "An act establishing the State Real Estate Commission and providing for the licensing of real estate brokers and salesmen," further providing for right to cancel certain agreements or contracts for the sale of residential real estate.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 609 of the act of February 19, 1980
10	(P.L.15, No.9), known as the Real Estate Licensing and
11	Registration Act, added June 29, 1990 (P.L.246, No.58), is
12	amended to read:
13	Section 609. Right to cancel sales agreements and sales
14	contracts for residential real estate and right
15	to cancel purchase of time share and campground
16	membership.
17	(a) A purchaser shall have the right to [cancel the purchase
18	of a time share or a campground membership until midnight of the
19	fifth day following the date on which the purchaser executed the
20	<pre>purchase contract.] cancel:</pre>

1 (1) a sales agreement or sales contract for real estate
2 containing a single-family residential dwelling unit;

3 (2) a sales agreement or sales contract for the sale of

4 <u>a lot or lots intended for construction of a single-family</u>

5 residential dwelling unit; and

6 (3) the purchase of a time share or a campground
7 membership. The purchaser's right to cancel shall continue
8 until midnight of the fifth day following the date on which
9 the purchaser executed the sales agreement, sales contract or
10 purchase contract.

11 (b) The right of cancellation shall be set forth
12 conspicuously in boldface type of at least ten point in size
13 immediately above the signature of the purchaser on the <u>sales</u>
14 <u>agreement</u>, <u>sales contract or purchase contract in substantially</u>
15 the following form:

16 "You, the purchaser, may cancel this purchase at any time 17 prior to midnight of the fifth day following the date of 18 this transaction. If you desire to cancel, you are required to notify the seller, in writing, at (address). 19 20 Such notice shall be given by certified return receipt mail or by any other bona fide means of delivery which 21 provides you with a receipt. Such notice shall be 22 23 effective upon being postmarked by the United States 24 Postal Service or upon deposit of the notice with any bona fide means of delivery which provides you with a 25 26 receipt."

- 27 This clause is to be separately initialed by the purchaser.
- 28 Copies of all documents which place an obligation upon a
- 29 purchaser shall be given to the purchaser upon execution by the
- 30 purchaser.

- 1 (c) Notice of cancellation shall be given by certified
- 2 return receipt mail or by any other bona fide means of delivery,
- 3 provided that the purchaser obtains a receipt. A notice of
- 4 cancellation given by a bona fide means of delivery shall be
- 5 effective on the date postmarked or on the date of deposit of
- 6 the notice with any bona fide means of delivery.
- 7 (d) Within ten business days after the receipt of a notice
- 8 of cancellation, all payments made under the sales agreement,
- 9 sales contract or purchase contract shall be refunded to the
- 10 purchaser and an acknowledgment that the contract is void shall
- 11 be sent to the purchaser. In the event of a cancellation
- 12 pursuant to this section, any promotional prizes, gifts and
- 13 premiums issued to the purchaser by the seller shall remain the
- 14 property of the purchaser.
- 15 (e) The right of cancellation shall not be waivable by any
- 16 purchaser.
- 17 (f) A purchaser who exercises the right of cancellation
- 18 shall not be liable for any damages as a result of the exercise
- 19 of that right.
- 20 (g) In addition to constituting a violation of this act, a
- 21 violation of this section by any individual, corporation,
- 22 partnership, association or other entity shall also be deemed a
- 23 violation of the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387),
- 24 known as the "Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection
- 25 Law." The Attorney General is authorized to enforce this
- 26 section. Any actions brought by the Attorney General to enforce
- 27 this section shall be in addition to any actions which the
- 28 commission may bring under this act.
- 29 (h) The right of the purchaser to bring an action to enforce
- 30 this section shall be independent of any rights of action which

- 1 this section confers on the Attorney General and the commission.
- 2 (i) Nothing in this act shall affect any rights conferred
- 3 upon the purchaser by 68 Pa.C.S. Pt. II Subpt. B (relating to
- 4 condominiums).
- 5 (j) This act shall be applicable to <u>real estate containing a</u>
- 6 <u>single-family residential dwelling unit</u>, to a lot or lots
- 7 <u>intended for construction of a single-family residential</u>
- 8 <u>dwelling unit</u>, and to time shares and campground memberships
- 9 which are located within this Commonwealth [and]; additionally,
- 10 this act shall be applicable to time shares and campground
- 11 memberships which are located outside this Commonwealth but for
- 12 which the purchase contract was executed by the purchaser within
- 13 this Commonwealth.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
