1 2 3 4	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting certain activities of alarm and security providers relating to disclosure of security codes and the provision of services.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 7328. Prohibited activities by security providers.
10	(a) Disclosure of access codes and termination of service
11	It is unlawful for any person, partnership, association,
12	corporation or other business entity which agrees by written
13	contract to provide security services by means of electronic
14	monitoring devices or alarms to:
15	(1) Disclose the purchaser's individual access code or
16	codes to any other person without the written consent of the
17	purchaser.

(2) Disconnect or terminate security services prior to

- 1 30 days' written notice to the purchaser of termination or
- 2 disconnection date.
- 3 (b) Penalty. -- A violation of subsection (a) is a misdemeanor
- of the third degree. 4
- 5 (c) Civil action. -- The provisions of this section shall not
- 6 foreclose any civil action for damages.
- 7 (d) Exception. -- Subsection (a) shall not apply where
- disclosure is required by law or by court order. 8
- 9 Section 2. This act shall apply to all contracts for
- 10 security services in effect on the effective date of this act.
- 11 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
