7	Section 1. Creation of clearinghouse.	<
8	The Self Help Clearinghouse of the Commonwealth is hereby	
9	created. It shall function within and under the supervision of

L1	Section 2. Duties of Department of Public Welfare.	
L2	The Department of Public Welfare shall have the following

L 4	(1) To prepare guidelines for the operation of the Self-

- 5 Section 3. Self help group development.
- 6 The Self Help Clearinghouse shall provide assistance to
- 7 develop self help groups throughout this Commonwealth by
- 8 providing technical aid to communities which shall include, but
- 9 not be limited to, the following:
- 10 (1) Consultation.
- 11 (2) Training.
- 12 (3) Technical advice.
- 13 (4) Publishing and distributing a Statewide directory of
- 14 self help groups.
- 15 (5) Collecting and making available self help
- 16 <u>information and resource material.</u>
- 17 Section 4. Effective date.
- 18 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 19 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 20 THIS ACT SHALL BE KNOWN AND MAY BE CITED AS THE SELF-HELP
- 21 CLEARINGHOUSE ACT.
- 22 SECTION 2. PURPOSE.
- 23 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS AND DECLARES AS FOLLOWS:
- 24 (1) THAT A NEED EXISTS TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO SELF-HELP
- 25 GROUPS FOR EVERY CITIZEN OF THIS COMMONWEALTH WHO IS FACING
- 26 AN OVERWHELMING PROBLEM, ISOLATED AND ALONE. THIS ACCESS CAN
- 27 BE PROVIDED THROUGH A SELF-HELP CLEARINGHOUSE.
- 28 (2) SELF-HELP GROUPS PROVIDE MUTUAL SUPPORT FOR
- 29 INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES SHARING A COMMON PROBLEM, SITUATION,
- 30 CHARACTERISTIC OR CONDITION, INCLUDING ABUSE, ADDICTION,

- 1 BEREAVEMENT, DISABILITIES, HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH/MENTAL
- 2 RETARDATION, PARENTING AND LIFE SITUATIONS.
- 3 (3) SELF-HELP GROUPS ARE OFTEN HIDDEN AND NOT AVAILABLE
- 4 TO INDIVIDUALS IN NEED OR PROFESSIONALS TRYING TO ASSIST.
- 5 (4) SELF-HELP GROUPS FOSTER INNOVATIVE AND COST-
- 6 EFFECTIVE HEALTH AND WELFARE SERVICES IN THIS COMMONWEALTH
- 7 WHICH WILL REDUCE THE NEED TO UTILIZE THE TREATMENT SYSTEM
- 8 AND DEVELOP AND STRENGTHEN COMMUNITY SUPPORT.
- 9 (5) THERE IS INCREASING SCIENTIFIC EVIDENCE THAT SELF-
- 10 HELP GROUPS CAN DRAMATICALLY REDUCE HOSPITAL STAYS, REDUCE
- 11 EMOTIONAL TRAUMA AND GENERALLY INCREASE QUALITY OF LIFE.
- 12 SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS.
- 13 THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES WHEN USED IN THIS ACT SHALL
- 14 HAVE THE MEANINGS GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE
- 15 CONTEXT CLEARLY INDICATES OTHERWISE:
- 16 "CLEARINGHOUSE." THE SELF-HELP CLEARINGHOUSE CREATED UNDER
- 17 SECTION 4.
- 18 "DEPARTMENT." THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE OF THE
- 19 COMMONWEALTH.
- 20 SECTION 4. CREATION OF CLEARINGHOUSE.
- 21 THE SELF-HELP CLEARINGHOUSE IS HEREBY CREATED. IT SHALL
- 22 FUNCTION UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 23 SECTION 5. DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT.
- 24 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL HAVE THE POWER AND ITS DUTY SHALL BE TO
- 25 ESTABLISH THE CLEARINGHOUSE AND PREPARE GUIDELINES FOR THE
- 26 OPERATION OF THE CLEARINGHOUSE.
- 27 SECTION 6. RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLEARINGHOUSE.
- 28 RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CLEARINGHOUSE MAY INCLUDE ANY OF THE
- 29 FOLLOWING:
- 30 (1) COLLECTING, ORGANIZING, MAINTAINING AND

- 1 DISSEMINATING SELF-HELP GROUP INFORMATION THROUGH A
- 2 COMPUTERIZED RESOURCE SYSTEM.
- 3 (2) PROVIDING IMMEDIATE AND DIRECT RESPONSES TO BOTH
- CITIZEN AND PROFESSIONAL INQUIRIES ABOUT SELF-HELP GROUPS 4
- 5 THROUGH A TOLL-FREE TELEPHONE SERVICE.
- 6 (3) PUBLISHING AND DISTRIBUTING MANUALS, NEWSLETTERS,
- 7 DIRECTORIES AND OTHER MATERIALS ON SELF-HELP ACTIVITIES IN
- 8 THIS COMMONWEALTH.
- 9 (4) ASSISTING IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATION OF LOCAL
- 10 SELF-HELP GROUPS WITHIN THIS COMMONWEALTH BY PROVIDING
- 11 TECHNICAL AID TO COMMUNITIES WHICH MAY INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT
- 12 LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:
- 13 (I) CONSULTATION.
- (II) TRAINING. 14
- 15 (III) TECHNICAL ADVICE.
- 16 SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 17 THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JULY 1, 1995.
