AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for limit on cancellations,
- 3 refusals to write or renew, surcharges, rate penalties and
- 4 point assignment by automobile insurers.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1799.3(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 1799.3. Limit on cancellations, refusals to renew, refusals
- 10 to write, surcharges, rate penalties and point
- 11 assignments.
- 12 (a) Damage claims. -- No insurer shall cancel or refuse to
- 13 renew a policy or apply any surcharge, rate penalty or driver
- 14 record point assignment where, during the preceding three-year
- 15 period, the aggregate cost of each accident to the insurer for
- 16 any person injured or property damaged is determined to be less
- 17 than \$650 in excess of any self-insured retention or deductible
- 18 applicable to the named insured.
