AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for limit on cancellations,
3 refusals to write or renew, surcharges, rate penalties and
4 point assignment by automobile insurers.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1799.3(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 1799.3. Limit on cancellations, refusals to renew, refusals
10 to write, surcharges, rate penalties and point
11 assignments.

12 (a) Damage claims.--No insurer shall cancel or refuse to
13 renew a policy or apply any surcharge, rate penalty or driver
14 record point assignment where, during the preceding three-year
15 period, the aggregate cost of each accident to the insurer for
16 any person injured or property damaged is determined to be less
17 than \$650 in excess of any self-insured retention or deductible
18 applicable to the named insured.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
