A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, limiting the number of session days of the
- 3 General Assembly.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 4 of Article II be amended to read:
- 9 § 4. Sessions.
- 10 The General Assembly shall be a continuing body during the
- 11 term for which its Representatives are elected. It shall meet at
- 12 12 o'clock noon on the first Tuesday of [January] February and
- 13 thereafter shall continue in session each year for 90
- 14 consecutive days and no more, unless a special session is called
- 15 by the Governor. Special sessions shall be called by the
- 16 Governor on petition of a majority of the members elected to
- 17 each House or may be called by the Governor whenever in his

1 opinion the public interest requires.
