AN ACT

1 2	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for a "USA-made" registration plate.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
6	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
7	<u>§ 1353. "USA-made" registration plate.</u>
8	<u>(a) General ruleThe department shall design a "USA-made"</u>
9	registration plate which shall prominently feature the American
10	flag. Upon application of any person, accompanied by a fee of
11	<u>\$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee,</u>
12	the department shall issue the plate for a passenger car, motor
13	home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not
14	more than 9,000 pounds.
15	(b) RestrictionRegistration plates shall be issued under
16	subsection (a) only for vehicles assembled in the United States
17	and containing parts at least 75% of which by value were

1 manufactured in the United States.

2	(c) Origin of partsA dealer who sells new or used
3	vehicles of the type enumerated in subsection (a) shall provide
4	the purchaser with a manufacturer's statement of the place of
5	assembly of the vehicle and the percentage of parts, by value,
6	manufactured in the United States.
7	(d) Request of ownerUpon request of the owner of a
8	vehicle of the type enumerated in subsection (a), the
9	manufacturer shall provide the owner with a statement of the
10	place of assembly of the vehicle and the percentage of parts, by
11	value, manufactured in the United States.
12	Section 2. This act shall take effect in six months.
