## AN ACT

Amending Title 30 (Fish) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, regulating alcohol content for persons under 21 years of age.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $5502(a)$ of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
§ 5502. Operating watercraft under influence of alcohol or controlled substance.
(a) General rule.--No person shall operate or be in actual physical control of the movement of a watercraft upon, in or through the waters of this Commonwealth while:
(1) under the influence of alcohol to a degree which renders the person incapable of safe operation of the watercraft;
(2) under the influence of any controlled substance, as defined by the laws of this Commonwealth and rules and
regulations promulgated thereunder, to a degree which renders
the person incapable of safe operation of a watercraft;
(3) under the combined influence of alcohol and a controlled substance; [or]
(4) the amount of alcohol by weight in the blood of the person is $0.10 \%$ or greater[.]; or
(5) the amount of alcohol by weight in the blood of a person under 21 years of age is greater than $0.00 \%$.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
