A RESOLUTION

- 1 Memorializing the President and the Congress of the United
- States to extend benefits to Americans who have or will have
- 3 exhausted their current unemployment benefits.
- 4 WHEREAS, Economic hardship continues throughout this
- 5 Commonwealth due to unemployment of Pennsylvania's workers,
- 6 particularly in the steel sector; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Congress has the authority to enact legislation to
- 8 provide extending benefits to more than 168,000 Pennsylvanians
- 9 who have or are expected to exhaust their regular unemployment
- 10 compensation benefits and to millions of America's other
- 11 unemployed workers; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That, in order to insure the funding of extended
- 13 unemployment compensation benefits to millions of America's
- 14 unemployed workers, the House of Representatives of the
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania call upon the President and the
- 16 Congress to make funds available to help more than 168,000
- 17 Pennsylvanians who need extended unemployment compensation
- 18 benefits by declaring it "Emergency Legislation"; and be it
