A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of May 22 through 29, 1993, as "Safe Kids
2 Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, A national effort, which began in January 1993 and
4 is culminating during National Safe Kids Week, May 22 through
5 29, 1993, is presently underway to reduce the risk of injury to
6 America's children; and

7 WHEREAS, In hundreds of communities across the country,
8 health professionals, injury prevention activists, businesses,
9 children's advocates, policymakers, national organizations, the
10 media and others concerned about children's lives are joining
11 together for this important effort; and

12 WHEREAS, Childhood injury is a problem that affects every
13 community across this country; and

14 WHEREAS, The incidence of childhood accidental injury
15 increases dramatically during the summer months when children
16 are released from school and spend a great deal of their
17 recreational hours outdoors; and

1 WHEREAS, It is vitally important to focus attention on the
2 problem of accidental injury, the need for preventive measures
3 and the need to educate the public on prevention and emergency
4 response; therefore be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
6 week of May 22 through 29, 1993 as "Safe Kids Week" in
7 Pennsylvania and call upon all residents of this Commonwealth to
8 join with thousands of others throughout the nation to make our
9 homes and communities safer for children.
