## A RESOLUTION

1 Awarding citations to the Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ <—  
2 OFFICERS, municipal police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY <—  
3 SHERIFFS, PAROLE OFFICERS AND PROBATION OFFICERS wounded in  
4 the line of duty.

5 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ OFFICERS, municipal <—  
6 police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, PAROLE OFFICERS AND <—  
7 PROBATION OFFICERS should be eligible to receive House citations  
8 when wounded in the line of duty; and

9 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ OFFICERS, municipal <—  
10 police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, PAROLE OFFICERS AND <—

1 PROBATION OFFICERS do an invaluable service for the public which  
2 often goes unrecognized; and

3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ OFFICERS, municipal <—  
4 police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, PAROLE OFFICERS AND <—  
5 PROBATION OFFICERS often put their lives at risk while upholding  
6 the laws of the Commonwealth; and

7 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ OFFICERS, municipal <—  
8 police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, PAROLE OFFICERS AND <—  
9 PROBATION OFFICERS wounded in the line of duty warrant the  
10 awarding of a citation; therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives shall award  
12 citations to Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ OFFICERS, municipal <—  
13 police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, PAROLE OFFICERS AND <—  
14 PROBATION OFFICERS wounded in the line of duty; and be it

16 RESOLVED, That citations may be requested by members of the  
17 House of Representatives to honor Pennsylvania State Police ~~and~~ <—  
18 OFFICERS, municipal police officers, SHERIFFS, DEPUTY SHERIFFS, <—

20 duty.
