A RESOLUTION

1 Opposing the encouragement of bigotry and racial segregation in
2 the statements of Hulond Humphries.

3 WHEREAS, Bigotry and racism in any form must be condemned,
4 particularly in cases where individuals entrusted to nurture our
5 students are involved;

6 WHEREAS, Members of the House of Representatives know that
7 racial tolerance is required under the Constitution of the
8 United States and the Constitution of Pennsylvania; and

9 WHEREAS, Members of the House of Representatives know that
10 they are required to uphold constitution truths and shall not
11 accept anything less from themselves; and

12 WHEREAS, On February 24, 1994, Hulond Humphries, Randolph
13 County High School principal, Wedowee, Alabama, said that
14 interracial couples would not be allowed to attend the prom and
15 that the prom would be canceled if interracial couples attended;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, Hulond Humphries has voiced and continues to

1 maintain a history of racial bias; therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives unequivocally
3 state that the encouragement of bigotry and racial segregation
4 in any form must be condemned; and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives stand united with
6 others with the courage and decency to speak out in opposition
7 to Hulond Humphries' racial intolerance or any such message of
8 bigotry, hatred or racial intolerance in this Commonwealth.
