A RESOLUTION

1 2	Directing the appointment of a task force to review issues concerning higher education funding.
3	WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has more than 100 institutions of
4	higher education, including community colleges, State-owned
5	universities, State-related universities and private colleges
б	and universities; and
7	WHEREAS, These public and private institutions have a variety
8	of financial relationships with the Commonwealth; and
9	WHEREAS, The Commonwealth annually appropriates more than \$1
10	billion to support these higher education institutions and
11	students attending these institutions; and
12	WHEREAS, This system of institutions represents a significant
13	asset for the citizens of this Commonwealth at a time when there
14	is increasing public demand for access to postsecondary
15	education programs as well as diverse and increasing public
16	expectations concerning the missions of colleges and
17	universities; and

1 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has an interest in helping to maintain the financial viability of the various categories of 2 3 higher education institutions in order to preserve and enhance 4 the richness of Pennsylvania's system of higher education and 5 the educational opportunities for Commonwealth residents; and WHEREAS, It is in the interest of the Commonwealth to have 6 public policies which ensure appropriate, fair and adequate 7 8 distribution of available public resources to and among the various higher education sectors and institutions; therefore be 9 10 it

RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives appoint a Task Force on Higher Education Funding to review issues pertaining to the financing of higher education in this Commonwealth; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the membership of the Task Force shall include 16 34 members appointed in the following manner:

17 (1) Four members of the Education Committee, appointed
18 by the Speaker, one of whom shall be designated as the chair
19 of the Task Force.

20 (2) Four members of the Appropriations Committee,21 appointed by the Speaker.

(3) Three members of the Education Committee, appointedby the Minority Leader.

24 (4) Three members of the Appropriations Committee,25 appointed by the Minority Leader.

26 (5) Sixteen members appointed by the Speaker, upon 27 recommendations of the Pennsylvania Association of Colleges 28 and Universities, who shall include four representatives of 29 State-related universities, four representatives of community 30 colleges, four representatives of the State System of Higher 19940H0352R3993 - 2 - Education and four representatives of private institutions,
 at least one of whom shall be a representative of a State aided institution.

4 (6) The President of the Pennsylvania Association of5 Colleges and Universities.

6 (7) The President/CEO of the Pennsylvania Higher7 Education Assistance Agency.

8 (8) The Chair of the State Board of Education or a9 designee.

10 (9) The Secretary of Education or a designee;11 and be it further

12 RESOLVED, That the Task Force may take appropriate testimony 13 and make its inquiries and reviews at such places and at such 14 times as it deems necessary within this Commonwealth; and be it 15 further

16 RESOLVED, That the Task Force make a report of its findings 17 and recommendations to the full House no later than November 30, 18 1994.
