AN ACT

Making appropriations from a restricted revenue account within 2 the General Fund and from Federal augmentation funds to the 3 Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, the Office of Consumer Advocate in the Office of the Attorney General and 4 the Office of Small Business Advocate in the Department of 6 Commerce. 7 AMENDING THE ACT OF JULY 8, 1994 (P.L.444, NO.74), ENTITLED "A 8 SUPPLEMENT TO THE ACT OF JUNE 16, 1994 (P.L.344, NO.50), 9 ENTITLED 'AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1994-1995,' ITEMIZING PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT 10 11 PROJECTS, FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT PROJECTS, TRANSPORTATION 12 ASSISTANCE PROJECTS, REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE AND 13 REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE CAPITAL PROJECTS, FLOOD CONTROL PROJECTS AND KEYSTONE RECREATION, PARK AND CONSERVATION 14 15 PROJECTS TO BE CONSTRUCTED OR ACQUIRED OR ASSISTED BY THE 16 DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES, THE DEPARTMENT OF 17 ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS, 18 THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, THE PENNSYLVANIA FISH AND 19 BOAT COMMISSION OR THE PENNSYLVANIA GAME COMMISSION, TOGETHER 20 WITH THEIR ESTIMATED FINANCIAL COSTS; AUTHORIZING THE INCURRING OF DEBT WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE ELECTORS FOR 21 22 THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE PROJECTS TO BE CONSTRUCTED OR 23 ACQUIRED OR ASSISTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES, 24 THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS OR THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; 25 26 STATING THE ESTIMATED USEFUL LIFE OF THE PROJECTS; 27 AUTHORIZING CERTAIN WAIVERS; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; AND 28 MAKING REPEALS, " FURTHER PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC 29 IMPROVEMENT AND FLOOD CONTROL PROJECTS; AND ADDING A 30 REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROJECT.

- 13 Section 3. The sum of \$739,000 is hereby appropriated from
- 14 the restricted revenue account within the General Fund to the
- 15 Office of Small Business Advocate in the Department of Commerce
- 16 to provide for the operation of that office for the fiscal year
- 17 July 1, 1993, to June 30, 1994.
- 18 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1993, or
- 19 immediately, whichever is later.
