AN ACT

1 Making ~~an appropriation~~ APPROPRIATIONS to the Pennsylvania <—  
2 College of Optometry, Philadelphia.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 SECTION 1. THE SUM OF \$802,000 IS HEREBY APPROPRIATED TO THE <—  
6 PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY, PHILADELPHIA, FOR THE FISCAL  
7 YEAR JULY 1, 1992, TO JUNE 30, 1993, FOR INSTRUCTION.

8 Section ~~±~~ 2. The sum of ~~\$1,604,000~~ \$1,203,000 is hereby <—  
9 appropriated to the Pennsylvania College of Optometry,  
10 Philadelphia, for the fiscal year July 1, 1993, to June 30,  
11 1994, for instruction.

12 Section ~~2~~ 3. Payments to the Pennsylvania College of <—  
13 Optometry on account of the appropriation provided in ~~section 1~~ <—  
14 ~~shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the~~  
15 ~~basis of costs during the fiscal year.:~~ <—

16 (1) SECTION 1 SHALL BE MADE IN A LUMP SUM BY THE

1 SECRETARY OF EDUCATION.

2 (2) SECTION 2 SHALL BE MADE QUARTERLY BY THE SECRETARY  
3 OF EDUCATION ON THE BASIS OF COSTS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR.

4 Section ~~3~~ 4. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall <—  
5 provide full, complete and accurate information as may be  
6 required by the Department of Education or the majority chairman  
7 or the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the  
8 Senate or the majority chairman or the minority chairman of the  
9 Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives.

10 Section ~~4~~ 5. The Pennsylvania College of Optometry shall <—  
11 report its revenues and expenditures and present its financial  
12 statements in accordance with generally accepted accounting  
13 principles and procedures for educational institutions as set  
14 forth in the "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the  
15 "Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State  
16 System of Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-  
17 State-Related Colleges and Universities."

18 ~~Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1993, or~~ <—  
19 ~~immediately, whichever is later.~~

20 SECTION 6. THE PHILADELPHIA COLLEGE OF OPTOMETRY SHALL <—  
21 REPORT ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO BOTH  
22 THE MAJORITY AND MINORITY CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE  
23 APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEES BY SEPTEMBER 30, 1994, ON HOW STATE-  
24 APPROPRIATED FUNDS WERE EXPENDED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1993-1994 TO  
25 REDUCE THE COSTS TO PENNSYLVANIA-RESIDENT STUDENTS OR TO PROVIDE  
26 SERVICES TO PENNSYLVANIA RESIDENTS.

27 SECTION 7. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AS FOLLOWS:

28 (1) SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF THIS ACT AND THIS SECTION SHALL  
29 TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

30 (2) THE REMAINDER OF THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT JULY 1,

1        1993, OR IMMEDIATELY, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
