## AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 18 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " authorizing the Department 21 of General Services to provide for the installation of 22 original works of art in public buildings.
- 23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 24 hereby enacts as follows:
- 25 Section 1. Section 2401.1 of the act of April 9, 1929
- 26 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is
- 27 amended by adding a clause to read:

- 1 Section 2401.1. Specific Powers of the Department of General
- 2 Services. -- In addition to all other powers and duties set forth
- 3 in this act, the Department of General Services shall have the
- 4 power, and its duty shall be:
- 5 \* \* \*
- 6 (19.1) To commission original works of art to be installed
- 7 <u>in all public buildings constructed under this section, the cost</u>
- 8 of which may not exceed one per centum (1%) of the total cost of
- 9 the building. Artists shall be nominated by a committee
- 10 consisting of the project architect, a representative of the
- 11 agency or institution that will occupy the building, a
- 12 representative designated by the State Art Commission and a
- 13 representative of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Council on
- 14 the Arts. The nominations shall be submitted to the Secretary of
- 15 <u>General Services for approval.</u>

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
