AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, "further providing for the review of financial solvency of insurers. 21
- 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- 24 Section 1. Section 612-A introductory paragraph and
- 25 (1)(xviii) of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 26 as The Administrative Code of 1929, amended July 1, 1990
- 27 (P.L.277, No.67), are amended and the section is amended by

20	organization or other entity licensed
21	to transact the business of insurance

4	(b) Beginning July 1, 1993, and thereafter, all moneys
5	collected by the Insurance Department under subsection (a)(9)(i)
6	shall be paid into the Insurance Monitoring and Activities
7	Augmentation Account, which is hereby established and which
8	shall be a special restricted account within the General Fund.
9	Moneys in the Insurance Monitoring and Activities Augmentation
10	Account are hereby appropriated upon approval by the Governor to
11	the Insurance Department on a continuing basis and shall be used
12	to support the activities of the Insurance Department relating
13	to monitoring and solvency activities related to insurers.
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
