AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the
- 3 sentencing procedure for murder of the first degree.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 9711 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 9711. Sentencing procedure for murder of the first degree.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (e.1) Mental retardation. -- A person who is mentally retarded
- 11 may not be sentenced to death. For purposes of this subsection,
- 12 <u>"mentally retarded" means having significantly subaverage</u>
- 13 general intellectual functioning existing concurrently with
- 14 <u>deficits in adaptive behavior. An intelligence quotient</u> of 70 or
- 15 below on a reliably administered intelligence quotient test may
- 16 be presumptive evidence of mental retardation. The burden of
- 17 proof of mental retardation shall be with the defendant. Mental
- 18 retardation must be proven by a preponderance of the evidence.

- 2 Section 2. This act shall apply to sentences imposed on or
- 3 after the effective date of this act.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
