AN ACT

- 1 Providing for the observance of the first Thursday in May of 2 each year as "Commonwealth Day of Prayer."
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Designation of "Commonwealth Day of Prayer."
- 6 The first Thursday in May of each year shall be designated
- 7 "Commonwealth Day of Prayer," and the Governor is urged to
- 8 request its observance as a day on which the people of this
- 9 Commonwealth may turn to God in prayer and meditation at
- 10 churches, in groups and as individuals.
- 11 Section 2. Effective date.
- 12 This act shall take effect immediately.
