16	Section 1. The act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known

19	Section 509. Sewer and Water Line Coverage In addition to
20	other types of insurance currently offered, all homeowner's

- Section 2. The Insurance Commissioner shall adopt such rules 3
