## AN ACT

Repealing the act of June 17, 1913 (P.L.507, No.335), entitled 2 "An act to provide revenue for State and county purposes, 3 and, in cities coextensive with counties, for city and county purposes; imposing taxes upon certain classes of personal 5 property; providing for the assessment and collection of the 6 same; providing for the duties and compensation of 7 prothonotaries and recorders in connection therewith; and modifying existing legislation which provided for raising revenue for State purposes." 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 11 12 Section 1. The act of June 17, 1913 (P.L.507, No.335), 13 referred to as the Intangible Personal Property Tax Law, is repealed. 14 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
