AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 20 commissions shall be determined, " providing for a State park 21 fee discount to residents 65 years of age and older.

- 23 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 1906-A of the act of April 9, 1929
- 25 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is
- 26 amended by adding a clause to read:

- 1 Section 1906-A. Parks.--The Department of Environmental
- 2 Resources shall have the power, and its duty shall be:
- 3
- (12) To provide Commonwealth residents sixty-five years of 4
- 5 age or older a discount of fifty per centum (50%) of the amount
- of any fee charged by a State park for activities, admissions, 6
- uses or privileges. This discount shall be effective on each and 7
- every day of the year. The department and the Environmental
- Quality Board shall promulgate regulations to administer this
- 10 clause.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
