AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for sentences
3 for theft.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 9719.1. Sentences for theft.

9 (a) Mandatory sentence.--A person convicted of the following
10 offenses shall be sentenced to a mandatory term of imprisonment
11 as follows:

12 18 Pa.C.S. § 3921 (relating to theft by unlawful taking
13 or disposition) - not less than 90 days.

14 18 Pa.C.S. § 3928 (relating to unauthorized use of
15 automobiles and other vehicles) - not less than 30 days.

16 (b) Eligibility for parole.--Parole shall not be granted
17 until the minimum term of imprisonment has been served.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
