## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 2 Statutes, further providing for exemptions from the motorbus 3 road tax. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 9804 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read: § 9804. Exemptions. The requirements of this chapter do not apply to the 9 10 following motorbuses: 11 (4) A motorbus owned and registered to: 12 (i) A nonprofit youth center, YOUTH CAMP OR 13 NONPUBLIC SCHOOL. 14 15 (ii) The American Red Cross. (iii) A church. 16

1 (iv) The Girl Scouts of America. 2 (v) The Boy Scouts of America. 3 (vi) The Salvation Army. (vii) A duly chartered post of national veterans' 4 5 organizations. (viii) The Young Men's Christian Association. 6 (ix) The Young Men's Hebrew Association. 7 (x) The Young Women's Christian Association. 8 (xi) The Young Women's Hebrew Association. 9 (xii) A Jewish community center. 10 (xiii) A nonprofit corporation of musical marching 11 12 groups of youths. 13 (xiv) A nonprofit organization which cares for or otherwise provides services for the elderly or the 14 infirm. 15 16 (xv) A nonprofit organization which principally serves persons with a mental or physical handicap or 17 18 disability. Section 2. The amendment of 75 Pa.C.S. § 9804 shall be 19 20 retroactive to August 10, 1992.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
