AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 15, 1957 (P.L.901, No.399), entitled
2 "An act giving cities of the third class the right and power
3 to adopt one of several plans of optional charters and to
4 exercise the powers and authority of local self-government
5 subject to certain restrictions and limitations; providing
6 procedures for such adoption and defining the effect
7 thereof," providing for residence of employees.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of July 15, 1957 (P.L.901, No.399), known
11 as the Optional Third Class City Charter Law, is amended by
12 adding a section to read:

13 Section 605.1. All employes of cities subject to this act
14 shall reside in the city within six months of their employment.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in six months.
