AS AMENDED ON THIRD CONSIDERATION, IN SENATE, JUNE 28, 1995

AN ACT

1 Making appropriations to the Trustees of the University of  
2 Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be  
6 necessary, are hereby appropriated to the Trustees of the  
7 University of Pennsylvania for the fiscal year July 1, 1995, to  
8 June 30, 1996, for the purposes and in the amounts as shown:

9 (1) For instruction to Pennsylvania residents, 10 excluding Veterinary Medicine programs and Doctor 11 of Medicine.....	\$9,489,000	
12 (2) For dental clinics.....	994,000	
13 (3) For instruction in the Doctor of Medicine 14 program.....	4,280,000	
15 (4) For instruction in Veterinary Medicine 16 programs only.....	10,456,000	<—

6     Section 2. Payments to the University of Pennsylvania on  
7 account of the appropriations for the items provided in section  
8 1 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the  
9 basis of costs during the fiscal year. The secretary shall not  
10 release more than the first quarterly payment until such time as  
11 the trustees of the University of Pennsylvania agree in writing  
12 to include a minimum of four members appointed by the General  
13 Assembly. The President pro tempore of the Senate, the Minority  
14 Leader of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of  
15 Representatives and the Minority Leader of the House of  
16 Representatives may each, upon receipt of the written agreement  
17 from the trustees, appoint a nonelected official to serve as a  
18 member of the board and the terms of office shall be coterminous  
19 with that of their appointing authority.

20     Section 3. The University of Pennsylvania shall provide  
21 full, complete and accurate information as may be required by  
22 the Department of Education or the chairman or the minority  
23 chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the  
24 chairman or the minority chairman of the Appropriations  
25 Committee of the House of Representatives.

26     Section 4. The University of Pennsylvania shall report its  
27 revenues and expenditures and present its financial statements  
28 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles and  
29 procedures for educational institutions as set forth in the  
30 "Higher Education Finance Manual (1975)" and the "Commonwealth

1 of Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of  
2 Higher Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-  
3 Related Colleges and Universities."

4 Section 5. The trustees of the University of Pennsylvania  
5 shall report on forms provided by the Department of Education to  
6 both the chairman and minority chairman of the Appropriations  
7 Committee of the Senate and the chairman and minority chairman  
8 of the Appropriations Committee of the House of Representatives  
9 by September 30, 1996, on how State-appropriated funds were  
10 expended for fiscal year 1995-1996 to reduce the costs to  
11 Pennsylvania resident students or to provide services to  
12 Pennsylvania residents.

13 Section 6. This act shall take effect July 1, 1995, or  
14 immediately, whichever is later.
