## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Titles 30 (Fish) and 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for fishing licenses and for hunting licenses and fees.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. The introductory paragraph of section 2706 of
7	Title 30 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended
8	and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read:
9	§ 2706. Complimentary licenses.
10	<u>(a) General</u> The commission may issue annually not more
11	than 100 fishing licenses [without fee] <u>for a fee of \$1</u> and in
12	such form as the commission may determine. Licenses may be
13	granted to any of the following persons:
14	* * *
15	(b) TemporaryIn addition to the licenses issued under
16	subsection (a), the commission shall issue a fishing license for
17	a fee of \$1 in such form as the commission may determine to an

1	individual who meets all of the following:
2	(1) Is a resident of this Commonwealth.
3	(2) Is on full-time active duty in the military service
4	of the United States.
5	(3) Is assigned to a facility outside this Commonwealth.
6	(4) Is on temporary leave in this Commonwealth.
7	Section 2. Section 2706 of Title 34 is amended by adding a
8	subsection to read:
9	§ 2706. Resident license and fee exemptions.
10	* * *
11	(e) Military personnelNotwithstanding any other
12	provisions of this title, a resident of this Commonwealth who is
13	on full-time active duty in the military service of the United
14	States, who is assigned to a facility outside this Commonwealth
15	and who is on temporary leave in this Commonwealth may, in
16	accordance with commission regulations as to time, manner and
17	number, hunt, kill or trap game birds, game animals and
18	furbearers without a hunting or furtaker license or any specific
19	type of license as required in this title. An individual who
20	uses this exemption must have in possession, while hunting or
21	taking game birds, game animals or furbearers, evidence of
22	residency in this Commonwealth and a copy of the military orders
23	assigning the individual to temporary leave.
24	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
