Section 1. Section 605(a) and (b) of the act of August 9,

- 12 Section 605. Establishment of Office of Controller in
- 13 Counties of the Sixth, Seventh and Eighth Classes. -- (a) The
- 14 office of controller may be established in any county of the
- 15 sixth, seventh or eighth class by the affirmative vote of a
- 16 majority of the electors of the county voting on the question
- 17 submitted, as herein provided, at [any] the general[, municipal
- 18 or primary] election held in the year immediately preceding the
- 19 municipal election for the election of auditors.

- 1 (b) The question shall be submitted to the electors of the
- 2 county upon petition, in writing, of one hundred qualified
- 3 electors of the county. Such petition shall be filed with the
- 4 county commissioners at least sixty days before the day of [any]
- 5 the general[, municipal or primary] election at which the
- 6 question is to be submitted in accordance with subsection (a).
- 7 If the petition is sufficiently signed the county commissioners
- 8 shall cause the question to be submitted in the manner provided
- 9 by the Pennsylvania Election Code.

- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
