## AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, further providing for required financial  
3 responsibility.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1786(d) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

8 § 1786. Required financial responsibility.

10 (d) Suspension of registration and operating privilege.--

11 \* \* \*

12 (3) The owner or registrant has previously been a clean  
13 risk for at least three years and the financial  
14 responsibility coverage required by this chapter has lapsed  
15 for a period not exceeding 90 days. Such owner or registrant  
16 may, in lieu of receiving a suspension of registration and

operating privilege, pay the following fines to the  
department:

(i) \$100 on days 1 to 60 following the initial date  
on which financial responsibility lapsed.

(ii) \$200 on days 61 to 90 following the initial  
date on which financial responsibility lapsed.

This paragraph shall not excuse an owner or registrant whose  
financial responsibility has lapsed from any other fines or  
penalties which may be imposed under this title.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
