## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for criminal
- 3 mischief.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3304(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3304. Criminal mischief.
- 9 \* \* \*
- 10 (b) Grading.--Criminal mischief is a felony of the third
- 11 degree if the actor intentionally causes pecuniary loss in
- 12 excess of \$5,000, or a substantial interruption or impairment of
- 13 public communication, transportation, supply of water, gas or
- 14 power, or other public service. It is a misdemeanor of the
- 15 second degree if the actor intentionally causes pecuniary loss
- 16 in excess of \$1,000, or a misdemeanor of the third degree if he
- 17 intentionally or recklessly causes pecuniary loss in excess of

- 1 [\$500] <u>\$150</u>. Otherwise criminal mischief is a summary offense.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
