## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for an
- 3 order of probation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 9771(a) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 9771. Modification or revocation of order of probation.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- The court may at any time terminate
- 10 continued supervision or lessen or increase the conditions upon
- 11 which an order of probation has been imposed. The court may,
- 12 with the written agreement of the defendant, extend the time
- 13 period of the probation to enable the defendant to comply with
- 14 the conditions of the probation.

- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
