AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, prohibiting the use of hearing impairment devices
- 3 by pedestrians while crossing State highways and roads.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3544 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 3544. Pedestrians walking along or on highway.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (e) Impairment of hearing.--No pedestrian upon a State
- 11 highway or roadway shall cross the highway or roadway while
- 12 wearing or using headphones, earphones or any similar device
- 13 which the department by regulation determines would impair the
- 14 ability of the pedestrian to hear traffic sounds, no matter if
- 15 the pedestrian is in an intersection, crosswalk or in another
- 16 area of the roadway or highway. This subsection does not
- 17 prohibit the use of hearing aids or other devices for improving
- 18 the hearing of a pedestrian.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
