AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 3 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 7 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 10 penalties," further providing for bonds and fines for 11 transient vendors. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 248.1 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, amended May 2, 1985 15 16 (P.L.28, No.13), is amended to read: 17 Section 248.1. Bond. -- (a) Upon registration with the 18 department, a transient vendor shall also post a bond with the department in the amount of [five hundred dollars (\$500)] three 19 thousand dollars (\$3,000) as surety for compliance with the 20

provisions of this article. After a period of demonstrated

- 1 compliance with these provisions, or, if the transient vendor
- 2 provides the license number of a promoter who has notified the
- 3 department of a show, in accordance with the provisions of
- 4 section 248.6(a), the department may reduce the amount of bond
- 5 required of a transient vendor or may eliminate the bond
- 6 entirely.
- 7 (b) A transient vendor may file a request for voluntary
- 8 suspension of certificate with the department. If the department
- 9 is satisfied that the provisions of this article have been
- 10 complied with and has possession of the transient vendor's
- 11 certificate, it shall return the bond posted to the transient
- 12 vendor.
- 13 Section 2. Section 248.4 of the act, added December 22, 1983
- 14 (P.L.300, No.82), is amended to read:
- 15 Section 248.4. Fines.--Any transient vendor conducting
- 16 business within the Commonwealth without a certificate or while
- 17 its certificate is suspended or revoked, as provided by sections
- 18 248.1(b) and 248.2(c), shall for the first offense be guilty of
- 19 a misdemeanor of the [third] second degree and, upon conviction
- 20 thereof, shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding [two
- 21 thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500)] five thousand dollars
- 22 (\$5,000) and for each subsequent offense shall be quilty of a
- 23 misdemeanor of the first degree and, upon conviction thereof,
- 24 shall be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding ten thousand
- 25 <u>dollars (\$10,000)</u>.
- 26 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
