## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for visitation
- 3 rights; and making repeals.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5311 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 5311. [When parent deceased] <u>Grandparents</u>.
- 9 [If a parent of an unmarried child is deceased, the parents
- 10 or grandparents of the deceased parent may] Grandparents and
- 11 great-grandparents shall be granted reasonable partial custody
- 12 or visitation rights, or both, to [the] an unmarried child by
- 13 the court upon a finding that partial custody or visitation
- 14 rights, or both, would be in the best interest of the child.
- 15 [and would not interfere with the parent-child relationship. The
- 16 court shall consider the amount of personal contact between the

- 1 parents or grandparents of the deceased parent and the child
- 2 prior to the application.] An order denying visitation rights to
- 3 grandparents and great-grandparents shall be in writing and
- 4 shall state the reasons for denial.
- 5 Section 2. Sections 5312, 5313 and 5314 of Title 23 are
- 6 repealed.
- 7 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
