A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the State Government Committee to study the
- 2 privatization or contracting out of government services.
- 3 WHEREAS, It may be beneficial to Pennsylvania's taxpayers for
- 4 State government to privatize or contract out many of the costly
- 5 services it now provides through State agencies, including, but
- 6 not limited to, the Department of Transportation's Bureau of
- 7 Driver's License and Registration processing centers; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This has been tried successfully in other states;
- 9 therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the State Government Committee make a study of
- 11 the feasibility of privatizing many State services; and be it
- 12 further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 14 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 15 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
- 16 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 17 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
- 2 and recommendations to the full House of Representatives within
- 3 one year of the date of adoption of this resolution.
