AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for accidents involving death or
3 personal injury.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3742(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 3742. Accidents involving death or personal injury.

9 * * *

10 (b) Penalties.--

11 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any
12 person violating this section commits a misdemeanor of the
13 [third] first degree.

14 (2) If the victim suffers serious bodily injury or
15 death, any person violating subsection (a) commits a
16 [misdemeanor of the first] felony of the third degree.

17 (3) If the violation of subsection (a) materially
18 contributes to any serious bodily injury suffered by the

1 victim, any person violating subsection (a) [commits a
2 misdemeanor of the first degree and] shall, upon conviction,
3 be sentenced to [pay a fine of not more than \$10,000 and to
4 imprisonment for not less than 90 days nor more than five
5 years.] a mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of one year
6 and a mandatory minimum fine of \$1,000.

7 (4) If the violation of subsection (a) materially
8 contributes to the death of the victim, any person violating
9 subsection (a) [commits a felony of the third degree and]
10 shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to [pay a fine of not
11 more than \$15,000 and to imprisonment for not less than one
12 year nor more than seven years.] a mandatory minimum term of
13 imprisonment of two years and a mandatory minimum fine of
14 \$2,500.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
