AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for criminal
3 trespass.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 3503 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:

8 § 3503. Criminal trespass.

9 * * *

10 (b.1) Simple trespasser.--

11 (1) A person commits an offense if, knowing that he is
12 not licensed or privileged to do so, he enters or remains in
13 any place for the purpose of:

14 (i) threatening or terrorizing the owner or occupant
15 of the premises;

16 (ii) starting or causing to be started any fire upon
17 the premises; or

1 (iii) defacing or damaging the premises.

2 (2) An offense under this subsection constitutes a
3 summary offense.

4 * * *

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
